The University of Alberta, Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry, Department of Medicine, Division of Preventive Medicine, in partnership with Alberta Health Services, invites applications for the Division Director position to be based at the University of Alberta. The successful candidate will be offered a tenured or tenure track appointment at the Full or Associate Professor level within the Department.

Located in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, the Faculty has been internationally recognized as among the world's top 50 medical schools and as one of Canada's premier health-education institutions. The University is currently home to 39,000 students and 15,000 faculty and staff. The University has an annual budget of \$1.8 billion and attracts more than \$480 million in sponsored research revenue.

The Division of Preventive Medicine at the University of Alberta is focused on ensuring excellence in clinical practice, research and teaching. Along with fully accredited Residency Programs in Public Health Preventive Medicine and the subspecialty Occupational Medicine, the Division currently provides clinical services in occupational and environmental medicine and provides clinical support to public health within AHS. In addition to the residency programs, the Division contributes to teaching of undergraduate medical students and to graduate teaching within the School of Public Health. The Division has developed a flagship course in occupational medicine for community practitioners, which is now offered through academic sites throughout Canada. Among the excellent research facilities are a mobile clinical laboratory, purchased through the Canadian Foundation for Innovation, an occupational hygiene laboratory specializing in the characterization of nanoparticles and a five year cohort study of female trades women across Canada, now nearing the end of data collection. The Department is seeking a dynamic, visionary leader who will be supportive of all elements in the Division and, in collaboration with the School of Public Health, further develop the Division to rival the best within Canada and beyond. The successful candidate will be an active advocate for the Division, and will be collegial and consultative in leadership to drive educational innovation, maximize research output and lead strategic growth initiatives. The Division Director will be required to participate and advance the research, education and clinical mandate within the Department of Medicine.

The successful candidate will be an MD with certification in either Public Health Preventive Medicine or Occupational Medicine with the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada or equivalent and be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA). He or she will be recognized internationally through scholarly accomplishment in research and teaching. Preference will be given to individuals with administrative experience in an academic setting.

Remuneration will be on the Academic Alternative Relationship Plan (A-ARP), which offers a very competitive remuneration package with excellent benefits.
