The University of Ottawa is North America's largest bilingual institution of higher learning and research, situated in the capital of Canada. The Faculty of Medicine — one of Canada's five most research-intensive faculties, with over \$136 million of research funding annually — seeks a dynamic and visionary leader of its newly established School of Epidemiology, Public Health and Preventive Medicine (SEPHPM). This research-intensive school boasts a vibrant environment with research and teaching foci in multiple health-related fields, and has strong partnerships with several University of Ottawa-affiliated research institutes and numerous governmental agencies. It offers a graduate program in epidemiology with over 130 Master's and PhD students. It also participates in interdisciplinary graduate programs and professional undergraduate and postgraduate medical education, including offering a Public Health and Preventive Medicine Residency program. The Director, with faculty members, will have the opportunity to further develop the School's strategic vision, building on research strengths in diverse areas related to the determinants of health and disease etiology and the development, implementation and evaluation of health-related practices, programs and policies.

The successful candidate will have a demonstrated track record of academic and research excellence, including a broad understanding of the full spectrum of population and public health. The candidate will have strong communication, leadership, and management abilities.

**Title of the position:** Director, SEPHPM, with an academic rank of Associate or Full Professor commensurate with the candidate's level of experience.

**Functions:** The successful candidate will become a member of the academic staff in a tenure-track position, and will be subject to the collective agreement of the Association of Professors of the University of Ottawa (APUO). The role of full-time academic staff includes, in varying proportions: a) research activities; b) teaching activities, including the supervision of graduate students; and c) academic service activities. The successful candidate will provide leadership in facilitating the development and support of research partnerships with the School across a spectrum of units including academic units, Research Institutes, Faculties within the University, and partner agencies. In addition, the successful candidate will promote the engagement of affiliated research institutes, partner agencies, and other university faculties, which include more than 100 cross-appointed and adjunct faculty.

**Wage:** Salary is commensurate according to rank and experience based on the APUO Collective Agreement. Note: salary for higher ranks is commensurate according to rank and experience. An additional administrative stipend is provided for the role of Director, SEPHPM.

**Benefits package:** The University of Ottawa provides a complete compensation package which includes long term disability, basic group life insurance, supplementary health insurance, University of Ottawa Pension Plan and optional life insurance.

- **Education:** PhD or MD/PhD in a relevant field.
- **Work experience:** Demonstrated outstanding administrative, leadership and management skills. A demonstrated excellent research track record in a health-related field. A demonstrated track record in teaching and training at the graduate level, a strong track record in interdisciplinary collaboration, and excellent communication skills in either English or French. Passive knowledge of the other official language in Canada is a requirement for tenure. Second language training opportunities are offered by the University of Ottawa, and supported by the Faculty of Medicine.
